



ON STAGE - Empowering young migrants by employability skills through BIOGRAPHIC WORK and elements of DRAMA

Due to the worsening situation in European countries of young first and second generation migrants being unemployed and showing high drop-out rates in higher and further education, the **ON STAGE project** aims at empowering young migrants by improving their employability skills through biographic work and elements of drama.

The **ON STAGE project partners from Austria, Greece, Norway, Portugal and Spain** will develop didactic materials of use for VET providers and their staff working with first or second generation migrants when preparing for entering into the construction, health-care, retail, tourism or transportation/storage sector.

So far, there has been the **ON STAGE Kick-off meeting** in Stavanger (Norway) in December 2013 to meet and initiate the first research work that forms the basis for those didactic materials. BEST Institut für berufsbezogene Weiterbildung und Personaltraining GmbH, the project coordinator, is organising the **ONSTAGE Transnational transfer Workshop** in Vienna (Austria) from 29th-30th May 2014, to which teachers and trainers will be invited from all partner countries as a second main step in setting the product development into the context and real world of our target groups.
